

Sunrise Elementary PBS Lesson Plan

Skill: Being responsible, having integrity, being safe, and being enthusiastic.

Setting: Bathroom (Elementary)

Read Aloud to Students:

Today we are going to discuss the procedures of the bathroom.

- Flush toilets
- Wash hands with soap
- Use facility quickly and quietly
- Keep water in sink
- Report problems
- Keep restroom clean

Teacher Models for Students:

Example: Have students form 2 lines outside of the appropriate bathroom (boys or girls). Teacher takes three students into the appropriate bathroom. Teacher demonstrates how to lock door and flush toilet. Teacher shows students how to use 1 pump of soap, turn on water, and wash hands. Teacher demonstrates how to use hand dryer and exits the bathroom quietly. Upon exiting the bathroom, return to classroom line. If student does not need to use bathroom, they need to go to the end of classroom line.

Non-example: Students will form two lines outside appropriate bathroom (boys or girls); teacher will butt in front of the first student in line. Once in the restroom, the teacher will take their time in the bathroom while talking very loudly. After using the restroom, the teacher doesn't wash their hands and then exits the bathroom and returns to the front of the line. Discuss incorrect behaviors with students.

Example: Teacher models all appropriate steps to using the bathroom.

Student Role Play:

Students model all appropriate steps to using the bathroom with teacher feedback.

After the Lesson:

After returning to the classroom, allow time to discuss further and answer questions. If any problems arise, re-teach the lesson or seek additional resources.
