

Sunrise Elementary PBS Lesson Plan

Skill: Follow Directions

Setting: All Settings

Read Aloud to Students:

Today we are going to discuss the procedures of following directions.

- Use your active listening skills (active listening skills should be taught and practiced before this lesson)
- Decide if you understand the directions
- Ask questions if you do not understand directions

Teacher Models for Students:

Example: Teacher will demonstrate the appropriate steps of paying attention and being an active listener. Teacher will demonstrate how to ask questions, if the directions are not understood, in a responsible and respectful way.

Nonexample: Teacher will talk while directions are being given. Teacher will ask an entertaining question that doesn't pertain to the directions given. Teacher will begin to follow directions incorrectly.

Example: Teacher models all appropriate steps to following directions.

Student Role Play: Students model all appropriate steps to following directions with teacher feedback.

After the Lesson: After returning to the classroom, allow time to discuss further and answer questions. If any problems arise, re-teach the lesson or seek additional resources.
